APRIL 9, 2021 - SAN DIEGO 8 vs. TUCSON 6

The San Diego Gulls defeated the Tucson Roadrunners 8-6 at Tucson Convention Center Arena. The Gulls matched their club record for goals scored in a road game (8, last: Feb. 16, 2019 @ SJ) and continue to lead the AHL in goals scored with 96. The 14 combined goals scored by the two teams marks the most in a game in Gulls history. **Andrew Agozzino** recorded his first multi-goal game (2-1=3) as a member of the Gulls. Agozzino's first period power-play goal moved him into a tie for second most in the AHL with five. **Jacob Perreault** picked up three assists to tie the Gulls rookie record for most assists in a game set on three previous occasions (last: Sam Steel, Mar. 13, 2019 @ BAK (1-3=4). **Matt Lorito** scored his first multi-goal game (2-0=2) as a Gull and extended his point streak into a third game (3-1=4). **Brendan Guhle** recorded his first career multi-goal game (2-1=3), scoring his first and second goals of the season while matching his career high for points in a game. **Vinni Lettieri** recorded his seventh multi-point game (1-1=2) of the season and has points in nine of 11 games this season (8-8=16). **Lukas Dostal** made 46 saves in the effort to extend his winning streak to three games and improve his record to 8-7-0.

SAN DIEGO GULLS NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Gulls will conclude their weekend back-to-back set against the Tucson Roadrunners at Tucson Convention Center Arena Saturday (7:00 p.m. - TV: AHLTV; Radio: iHeartRadio). The Gulls own an all-time record of 201-125-21-10, including 108-58-9-5 at home and 93-67-12-5 on the road. San Diego leads the Pacific Division in all-time wins, points (433) and points percentage (.606%, min. two seasons) since the division's inception six seasons ago. San Diego leads the AHL in home wins (12), home points (24) and total goals scored (96). Following the game, San Diego will head home to open a midweek home-and-home series with the Ontario Reign beginning Tuesday, Apr. 13 at FivePoint Arena.

GULLS-ROADRUNNERS: San Diego and Tucson meet for the sixth contest of an eight-game season series tonight at Tucson Convention Center Arena. Tucson won the first two matchups between the clubs on Mar. 13 (4-1) and Mar. 20 (6-2), but the Gulls responded with wins in the next three contests on Mar. 21 (4-2), Mar. 27 (2-1), and Apr. 9 (8-6). In games against Tucson this season, **Benoit-Olivier Groulx** (2-3=5) and **Andrew Poturalski** (1-4=5) each pace San Diego in points with Poturalski leading in assists, while **Matt Lorito** (3-1=4) leads the team in goals. San Diego is 24-18-2-1 all-time against Tucson, including 12-9-1-0 on the road. The Gulls will host the Roadrunners again at FivePoint Arena on Friday, Apr. 30 (7 p.m.) and Saturday, May 1 (7 p.m.).

HIGH OCTANE OFFENSE: San Diego has enjoyed offensive success this season, leading the AHL in total goals scored (96), goals scored at home (56), and in power-play goals (21). By period, the Gulls rank first in first period goals (29), second in second period goals (33), and lead the AHL in third period goals (31). San Diego scored 20 goals over three games, Mar. 31 (7-2), Apr. 3 (7-3) and Apr. 4 (6-4), marking the first time in team history that the Gulls scored 6+ goals in three consecutive games. Over their last five games, San Diego has scored 30 goals to average six goals per game with 6+ goals scored in four of those five games.

STREAKING: The Gulls own a four-game road winning streak starting Mar. 21 (4-0-0-0). San Diego also held a sevengame win streak from Mar. 21 to Apr. 4 (7-0-0-0), marking a season high. The streak was one game shy of matching the club's record of eight games (set three times: Dec. 27, 2018-Jan. 12, 2019, Jan. 26-Feb. 17, 2018 and Nov. 11-Dec. 2, 2016). It also tied for the third longest win streak in the AHL this season, two shy of Bakersfield's nine game win streak from Feb. 19-Mar. 16. The Gulls' winning ways started at the beginning of the season when they matched a club record with seven consecutive home wins (7-0-0-0), which is tied for the second longest among AHL teams this season.

HOME SWEET HOME (ICE): With an 12-4-0-0 record on home ice, San Diego leads the AHL in home wins, home points (24) and goals scored at home (54). The Gulls recorded the 100th victory on home ice in club history on Feb. 13 vs. COL. San Diego leads the Pacific Division in all-time home wins (108), points (230) and point percentage (.642, min. two seasons).

POWERED BY POTS: Gulls right wing **Andrew Poturalski** recorded his 200th career AHL point with an assist on Sam Carrick's goal, Mar. 21 at TUC. Poturalski has earned 5-19=26 points in his last 20 appearances and leads the AHL in scoring (6-21=27), assists and co-leads in power-play assists (9). Signed by Anaheim to a one-year contract extension on Oct. 10, 2020, Poturalski has posted two career-tying three-assist performances (1-3=4, Feb. 20 vs. COL; 0-3=3, Mar. 3 @ ONT) and has recorded at least one point in 16-of-27 appearances this season. The second-year Gull also has multipoint efforts in three of his last four games played (1-5=6) and five of his last eight (2-9=11).

CAPTAIN CARRICK: Gulls captain **Sam Carrick** has already reached four prominent milestones early in the 2020-21 season. With an assist on Maxim Golod's game-winning goal on Mar. 24 @ ONT, Carrick recorded his 300th career AHL point (132-168=300). With two goals on Mar. 31 vs. ONT, Carrick reached the 10-goal mark for the sixth consecutive season and the 20-point mark for the eighth straight season. Carrick owns 83-94=177 points in 214 career games with San Diego. On Feb. 27, Carrick became the third player in club history to appear in 200 games with San Diego, joining Corey Tropp (205) and Jaycob Megna (216). With his goal vs. Colorado on Feb. 13, Carrick became the club's all-time leading scorer, surpassing Tropp (64-93=157). Carrick was recalled by the Anaheim Ducks on Apr. 4 and has earned two points (1-1=2) and a +1 rating in his first two appearances with the NHL club this season.

ROOKIES REWARDED: Two months into the season, two Gulls rookies have been selected for league-wide awards. On. Feb. 8, **Trevor Zegras** was named CCM/AHL Player of the Week after earning 2-3=5 points in his first two career AHL games. On Mar. 1, Gulls defenseman **Jamie Drysdale** was named CCM/AHL Rookie of the Month for February. Drysdale posted 4-5=9 points in his first 10 career AHL games, pacing league blueliners in goals and ranking second in scoring for the month. Selected by the Anaheim Ducks in the first round (sixth overall), Drysdale earned a goal and an assist in his second professional game on Feb. 6, becoming the youngest player in Gulls history to score a goal (18 years, 9 months, 28 days). Drysdale becomes the third Gull to be selected Rookie of the Month, joining Max Comtois (Feb. 2020) and Brandon Montour (Nov. 2015).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: The Gulls will play the remainder of their home games at FivePoint Arena at Great Park Ice in Irvine, Calif. for the 2020-21 season to ensure all players within the Anaheim Ducks organization are in one location under the same health protocols. The Gulls are committed to San Diego long-term and will return to Pechanga Arena San Diego for the 2021-22 season.

NOTABLE NUMBERS:

Sam Carrick rank tied for second in the AHL in shots (82) alongside teammate **Chase De Leo**. San Diego's captain has five multi-point efforts in his last 14 games played (8-6=14), including a season-high three-point effort on Mar. 31 vs. ONT. Carrick paces the Gulls in goals (12), and ranks second in power-play goals (4) and in scoring (12-9=21).

Andrew Poturalski leads the AHL in scoring (6-22=28), assists and co-leads in power-play assists (9). The second-year Gull has had multi-point efforts in five of his last nine games played (2-10=12).

Benoit-Olivier Groulx owns nine points (2-7=9) and a +8 rating in his last 10 games, leading the Gulls in plus/minus (+11) and shorthanded points (1-1=2), and ranking tied for sixh in scoring (6-10=16) among AHL rookies.

Josh Mahura and **Kodie Curran** rank second among AHL defensemen in goals (5), marking a career-high for each player. **Olle Eriksson Ek** held a five-game win streak from Mar. 21 to Apr. 3 (5-0-0), posting a 2.01 GAA and .923 SV% over that span. Eriksson Ek ranks think among rookie AHL goaltenders in GAA (2.27) and SV% (.919).

Five Gulls have appeared in all 28 games for San Diego this season: forwards Andrew Poturalski and Benoit-Olivier Groulx, as well as defensemen Keegan Lowe, Simon Benoit, and Trevor Carrick.

Kevin Dineen enters his second season as head coach of the San Diego Gulls, his fifth overall in the Anaheim Ducks organization. Named to his current post July 15, 2019, Dineen guided the Gulls to a 30-19-6-2 record in his first season with San Diego. A native of Quebec City, Quebec, Dineen was an assistant coach for the Chicago Blackhawks from 2014-18, helping the club to a Stanley Cup championship in 2015. He also previously served as head coach of the Florida Panthers from 2011-13, guiding the club to a 56-62-28 record, including its first Southeast Division title in 2011-12.

Dineen spent six seasons as head coach of the Portland Pirates (AHL) from 2005-11, leading his teams to a 266-155-59 record in 480 games. In three seasons as Anaheim's AHL affiliate, Dineen's teams went 135-76-29 (.623%) with two trips to the Eastern Conference Finals (2005, 2008). He was named the recipient of the Louis A.R. Pieri Memorial Award as the AHL's outstanding coach in 2005-06. Dineen leads Anaheim's primary affiliate head coaches in all-time wins (169), points (375) and point percentage (.623%)

Internationally, Dineen led the Canadian women's national team to a gold medal at the 2014 Winter Olympic Games in Sochi, Russia. He also led Canada's men's national team to a bronze medal at the 2014 Under-18 World Championship and a second-place finish at the 2018 Spengler Cup in Davos, Switzerland.

Selected by the Hartford Whalers in the third round (56th overall) of the 1982 NHL Draft, Dineen played 19 NHL seasons from 1984-2003, recording 355-405=760 points and 2,229 penalty minutes (PIM) in 1,188 career games with Hartford, Philadelphia, Carolina, Ottawa and Columbus. He is one of eight NHL players to record more than 300 goals and 2,000 PIM. Dineen also appeared in 59 career Stanley Cup Playoff games with Hartford, Philadelphia and Carolina, collecting 23-18=41 points. He also served as team captain while playing for Philadelphia, Hartford and Carolina.

As a player, Dineen appeared in two NHL All-Star Games (1988, 1989), and was named the NHL's Man of the Year in 1990-91 in recognition of his involvement with charitable activities. He was also named a finalist for the Bill Masterton Trophy on three occasions, awarded annually to the NHL player who best exemplifies the qualities of perseverance, sportsmanship, and dedication to ice hockey.

Dineen represented Canada in numerous international tournaments as a player, including the 1984 Winter Olympic Games in Sarajevo, Yugoslavia. He also helped lead Team Canada to the 1987 Canada Cup and appeared in three World Championships for Team Canada, winning silver on two occasions (1985 and 1989).

The 2020-21 AHL campaign marks Sylvain Lefebvre's third season as an assistant coach with the Gulls. In his first two campaigns with the club, Lefebvre helped guide San Diego to a 66-43-11-5 record and an appearance in the 2019 Calder Cup Western Conference Finals.

Lefebvre spent the previous six seasons as Head Coach of Montreal's primary AHL affiliate in Hamilton (2012-15), St. John's (2015-17) and Laval (2017-18). Prior to his AHL assignment with Montreal, he served as Assistant Coach with Colorado (NHL) for three seasons (2009-12) after spending two years (2007-09) as Assistant Coach with the Avalanche's AHL affiliate in Lake Erie.

Lefebvre is a veteran of 945 career NHL games with Montreal, Toronto, Quebec/Colorado and the New York Rangers. He recorded 30-154=184 points with a +108 rating during his 14-year NHL career. Lefebvre was part of Colorado's first Stanley Cup championship team in 1996 and went on to appear in 129 career Stanley Cup Playoff games. Lefebvre also played parts of four AHL seasons with Sherbrooke (1986-89) and Hartford (2001-02), earning 18-61=79 points in 171 career regular-season games.

ASSISTANT COACH: David Urquhart

David Urquhart is in the midst of his third season as an assistant coach for the Gulls. Urquhart helped San Diego to its third Calder Cup Playoff appearance in franchise history and first trip to the Western Conference Finals in 2018-19.

Prior to joining the Anaheim organization, Urquhart served as Assistant Coach with McGill University in Montreal for four seasons from 2014-18. He also served as Head Coach for Team Serbia at the 2018 IIHF World Hockey Championship Division II. Urquhart appeared in 130 career AHL games from 2008-11, collecting 6-17=23 points with a +8 rating with Hartford and Hamilton. Urquhart also played three seasons in Italy from 2011-14, highlighted by a league championship victory in 2013-14.

A native of Thorold, Ontario, Urquhart played four collegiate seasons with the McGill Redmen from 2004-08 and earned a commerce degree in 2008. Named to the 2006-07 All-Canadian Second Team, Urquhart recorded 23-84=107 points in 147 career games and led McGill to the Ontario University Athletics conference championship as captain in 2007-08. The three-time All-Star concluded his time at McGill as the eighth-highest scoring defenseman in Redmen history. Inducted into the McGill Sports Hall of Fame on Oct. 11, 2018, Urquhart completed a master's degree in Sports Psychology at McGill during the summer of 2019.
